A letter from the P&F Executive...

Dear St Andrews School Community,

To say 2020 has turned out quite differently to what we had planned is somewhat of an understatement. This year has certainly tested not only our physical strength and courage, but also our emotional and spiritual resilience and fortitude.

As a P&F we would again like to express our appreciation and gratitude for our wonderful school staff and all the pastoral care and support that they have provided for all our school families during these unprecedented times.

We would like to take this opportunity to let you know that despite these changes and challenges, the P&F exec and committee have continued to work hard to provide fun and enriching facilities, resources and future events for all the children. We have also thought it appropriate to review and explain the P&F funding structure at St Andrews at this time.

Instituted by Mrs Climo, the previous substantive school principal it was decided to introduce a P&F levy within the school fee structure to ensure equity and alleviated the need for significant fundraising throughout the year by all school families. In support of this our current P&F employs some gentle fundraising principals where parents can opt in or out of being involved e.g. Raffle tickets are sent home, without any obligation to buy.

All school families are invited to attend P&F school functions free of charge.

So far this year the P&F has used the levy for a number of significant projects and purchases which includes, but is not limited to:

- Welcome back to school function: incl. Blow up obstacle course and jumping castles, face painting and Old MacDonald's farm.
- Jeep for the adventure play ground
- Lexile reading books each year a significant amount of money is dedicated to this program, ensuring the children have access to the latest published works.
- New take home and in class reading books
- Library books
- New STEM games and equipment for STEM club
- Music equipment including instruments and music stands

- 15 new iPad deployed around the school by Mr Redding
- New school flags, including Faction and music stand flags we can't wait to unveil these when we're able to have whole school assemblies again.

Dependent on Federal and State Government decisions on further relaxation of social restrictions it is our intent to reschedule the school disco (usually held in term 2) later in the year and also to continue to hold the end of year St Andrews Day Splash Day.

Further infrastructure projects include plans for expansion of the nature play ground with sensory and sound equipment as well as a pergola to round out the final corner of this very popular play area.

Hope this gives you a glimpse into where your funds are going and how it benefits all of the children at St Andrews.
