### MUSIC NEWS - REMINDER: INSTRUMENTAL TUITION AND RECORDERS



All children in Years 2-5 have been provided with a Music Tuition Note. If you would like your child to have instrumental lessons in 2021, please return the application form to school as soon as possible. [This includes the children wishing to re-enrol.] I will be forwarding the completed forms to the tutors and they will be in touch with you, by email during the holidays. Thank you to those of you who have already returned their forms. The requirements are lists on the enrolment and re-enrolment note.

Recorder is taught to students in Years 3, 4 and 5 and every child in these year groups needs to have a recorder. Learning to read music is part of the Western Australian Curriculum. Recorders appear on each child's booklists and should be retained and used year after year. There is no need to purchase a new recorder each year.

Children who participate in the school's Music Tuition Program will be given priority when joining the School Band, Performing Arts, and the School's Music Gala.





### **ACTIVITIES FOR THE FINAL WEEK OF SCHOOL**

Monday 7<sup>th</sup> December: Footsteps Dance / Music Gala – School hall approx. 8:45am start. All invited



- Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> December: This is the last day for the Year 6 students. If they are bringing in items to sign, please be aware that they are not permitted to sign their school uniforms but are welcome to sign their graduation shirts under the supervision of teachers. No other parts of the uniform should be signed.
  - Year 6 students are not to attend school on Thursday or Friday unless they are in the school choir or band and are required by Mrs Mulholland. They should also just be at school for the event time and NOT for the entire day.
  - ❖ Year 6 Thanksgiving/Graduation Mass: This Mass will commence at 6:00pm sharp, in the Church. The children are expected to wear full Summer School Uniform with all boys wearing a tie. (Year 6 Students should be at Church by 5:45pm).
  - ❖ Year 6 Awards: ALL of these will be presented at a ceremony, to be held in the Hall at the conclusion of the Graduation/Thanksgiving Mass.
  - ❖ Second Semester Reports: Reports will be sent home on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> December via Seqta Engage. (Children in Year 6 will also be given a hard copy of their report on Wednesday afternoon.)
  - ❖ All children will be able to wear Free Dress for a gold coin donation to Catholic Christmas Charities. The Theme will be holidays/Christmas.

- <u>Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> December:</u> We commence our day with our final assembly for 2020. This assembly will be concluded with the singing of several Christmas Carols lead by Mrs Mulholland and the School Choir.
- 2021 Class Orientation session (PP-6) from approximately 10:40am 11:30am.
  The children will be directed to their new classes and meet with their new class members and teachers for 2021. An exciting time for all! We ask that <u>parents do not attend this event</u> for the children's sake to cause unnecessary anxiety.

The children have told me that they will be very excited to come home and share the good news with you rather than have parents attend and affecting the transition. The knowledge of the new class is always accompanied by some excitement and potential anticipation.
