All St Andrews CPS Students are invited to attend this **FREE** event coordinated by the P&F. The evening will again be separated into three discos ensuring each group has a great time and we comply with COVID restrictions:

Kindy & Pre-Primary	3:45 – 4:45pm
Years 1 to Year 3	5:15 – 6:30pm
Years 4 to Year 6	7:00 – 8:30pm

A reminder to parents that children must be escorted to and from the undercover area on the night – PLEASE REMEMBER TO MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCE.

Drop off at the door near the year 6 classrooms and pick-up from the Southern door on the hall's side of the undercover area.

Parents are invited to stay and watch the Kindy/PP disco however the other two discos will be drop off only.

Please note that only younger siblings are permitted at the Kindy and PP disco and no other siblings (younger or older) will be allowed at the other discos. No student or siblings

from other years will be able to attend a disco that is not allocated for them. Siblings will also not be allowed to play anywhere else on the school grounds.

Any children who are on school grounds unsupervised during sibling discos will be asked to leave.

Discos are for current St Andrew's Primary School students only. Parents please note: If you are staying for the Kindy/ PP Disco, we remind you, as per our school policy, to refrain from videoing or photographing children other than your own children at the disco.

No phones or devices are permitted into the disco. If you insist that your child requires a phone on the night, it can be signed in when you drop them off and will be looked after by the volunteers during the disco.

The discos are free dress but please ensure that students are dressed appropriately for the night.

A light snack of a packet of popcorn will be provided on the night. Children are welcome to bring a labelled water bottle and they will also have access to the water fountains. As only a light snack is provided please make sure your child eats before or after the event.

A Big Thank You in advance to all the parents who have volunteered to assist on the night - without you, the event would not be possible. Again, please remember social distancing whilst supervising the kids.

CHILD AND ADOLESCENT MENTAL HEALTH SERVICE - EMERGENCY TELEHEALTH SERVICE

What do we do?

The Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service (CAMHS) Emergency Telehealth Service (ETS) provides support for children and young people experiencing a mental health crisis, as well as support and advice to families and carers.

Our aim is to provide expert help to children and young people quickly, when they need it most.

This includes mental health advice, crisis management, assessment and referral to the most appropriate service depending on need.

The service will be accessible to young people, families and carers as well as health professionals in the community including GPs, school psychologists, community nurses, across the metropolitan area.

Children and young people in regional WA have access to the WA Country Health Service (WACHS) Emergency Tele-mental Health Service.

Emergency tele-mental health assessments will be accessible to young people in the community up to the age of 18 years.

How does the service work?

The CAMHS **1800 048 636** urgent mental health line is the entry point to the CAMHS ETS.

The service is staffed with Mental Health Clinical Nurse Specialists and a Consultant Child and Adolescent Psychiatrist between 8am and 2.30am, seven days a week.

The CAMHS ETS will gather information from the caller and may:

- Provide advice, support and guidance
- Offer a tele-mental health assessment
- Recommend presentation to an Emergency Department for a face to face mental health assessment

CAMHS ETS care should be provided to a young person with a safe adult present.

If this is not possible, crisis support or direction to an ED for a face to face assessment may be provided.



For a telehealth assessment you will need a computer or phone with microphone and camera, reliable internet connection and latest version of web browser where possible

What will happen when a tele-mental health assessment is completed?

Every CAMHS ETS tele-mental health assessment will include an initial mental health assessment, risk assessment and discharge plan.

Young people, families and carers may be referred to a community mental health service or advised that an admission to an inpatient mental health unit may be required.

Every young person seen will be offered follow up from the CAMHS ETS within 24 hours.
