- Telephone discussions between parents/caregivers and teachers and informal encounters and discussions.
- Annotations in homework diaries and journals.
- Letters, email, and other forms of correspondence from teachers and school to advise parents/caregivers about successes or concerns.
- Student-directed reporting, in which students show how their knowledge, skills and understandings have developed through discussions or presentations of key achievements.
- Formalized testing.
- Responses to requests from parents for additional information.
