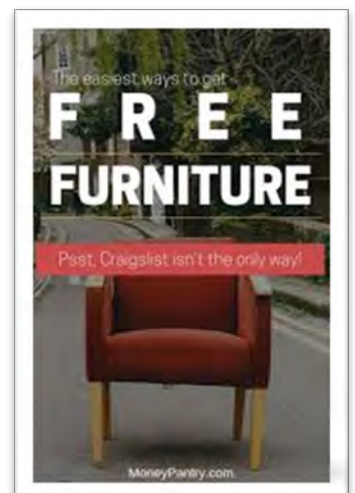


BOOK WEEK 2021 DRESS UP PARADE – TUESDAY 24th AUGUST

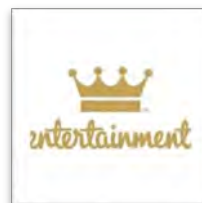


Father's Day raffle tickets came home this week. Please be sure to return them with the money by Wednesday 1st September. There are some great prizes up for grabs so don't miss out!

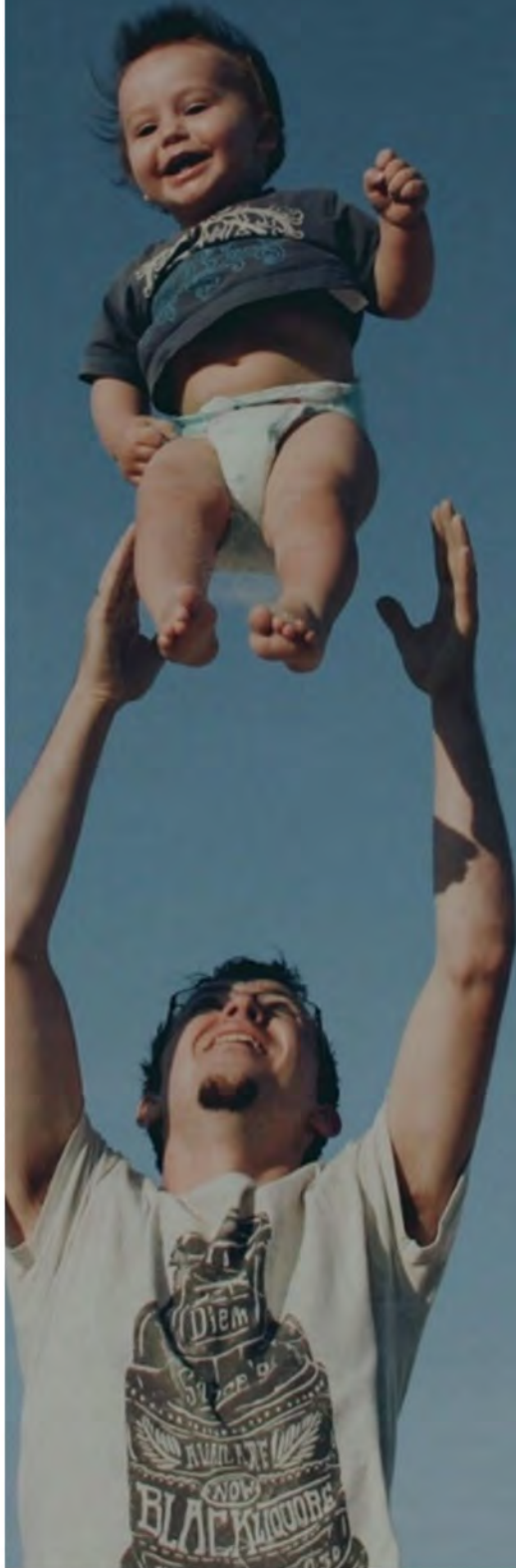
