Dear Parents,

This is the final newsletter for 2023!

Our school continues to be at the forefront of presenting a comprehensive Catholic education to everyone in Clarkson and the surrounding suburbs. We are Christ centred, child focussed. I am so proud of all of the children and the staff's resiliency and agility in 2023! The initiative shown by the children as well as the collaborative open-ended tasks, devised by the teachers have been a credit to all. So much has been achieved and we eagerly look forward to 2024 with renewed vigour and excitement, and of course, sound health. We are blessed with wonderful teachers, staff, students and parents. Our community continues to flourish from strength to strength.

I will continue to pray for you all at our school and know that great things will continue to happen. On Wednesday night, I was fortunate to attend the Year 6 Graduation Mass and associated ceremony in the Parish Church and School Hall. We have had an enthusiastic and enjoyable Year 6 group of children attend St. Andrew's this year. I enjoyed a productive relationship with them all and know with their outstanding teachers, that they will leave St. Andrew's proud and with an ongoing respect to achieve their personal best. Good luck to all of the Year 6 students and I wish them well for their exciting futures.

YEAR 6 GRADUATION OUTING

Last Friday, I was very happy to be invited by our current Year 6 students to their graduation outing. This event was held at Perth's Outback Splash. The weather proved to be great, and the children had a very enjoyable time. I thank Mrs Campbell, Mr Kelly, Mrs Peacham, Mrs Stokes, Mrs Holden and Mrs Baldock for all of their efforts to make this event the success that it was.



On Tuesday, we celebrated our 2023 Kindy Class Graduation and Christmas Party. The children had a wonderful time performing several songs, enjoying face painting and meeting with Santa. Congratulations to all of our Kindergarten children on an outstanding year.

Thursday, we celebrated our final gathering together as a school, with our Christmas Assembly. The choir led the school into our Christmas celebrations by singing several Christmas carols and we had our final notices. It was a very meaningful way to finish off the formal part of our 2023 school year.

This year, the School Advisory Council and I have worked very hard to keep school tuition fees increase for 2024 to a minimum. That is, there will be a **Object increase in school tuition fees and the building levy for 2024.** In fact, we have extended a 0% increase to many levy line items on the school fee account. (Even though there have been some increases from suppliers, the school will absorb the costs for the benefit of all of the families and especially with the sharp increase in the cost of living.) There will, however, be some small increases to line items which are simply the increase what has been passed on to us by the supplier. A copy of the school fees is attached to the end of this newsletter. Parents should note that over the last 5 years, we have managed to have 0% fee increase and one year of a 2% fee increase which equated to just over \$30 for the whole year. Thank you to all involved, especially our very prudent finance staff and the Parent Advisory Council.

CONCESSION CARD UPDATE

As you are aware from the information presented in past newsletters and from the press, in 2024 Concession Card Holders will be eligible for a reduction in school tuition fees. Catholic Education Western Australia have made a decision to extend the Scheme making those PCC holders receiving a "Parenting Payment Single" payment – code PPS on the card eligible for the same concession as HCC holders. The CEWA website www.cewa.edu.au contains further information and parents can log on and follow the links. Alternatively, parents are welcome to book a confidential appointment with Mr. Fontaine to discuss their individual situation further. More information will be sent home to all families at the commencement of the 2024 school year.

THE RIGHT FOR STAFF TO DISCONNECT

As a part of the new staff employment agreement, there is a section whereby all staff, at any school, have the right to disconnect. In essence, that means that we ask families not to contact staff out of normal operational hours. If you intend to send a message late at night, I ask that you save it and send it first thing in the morning. This email affects staff wellbeing as some staff monitor their messages or it comes through onto their phone. This also is applicable for the admin email account. Parents should also be aware that, while we have a very accommodating and kind staff, that they are not on technology while teaching your child and hence, may not see the communication until the end of the school day. Therefore, if you have an urgent message of any description, it is still advisable that you contact Mrs. Champion or Mrs Puca at the front administration office on 6206 4100. Your respect and assistance in this matter is most appreciated.


EXTERNAL SERVICE PROVIDERS AT SCHOOL IN 2024

In 2024, St Andrew's Catholic Primary School will continue to support parents/guardians who wish to engage external service providers during school hours when their child requires additional health, therapy or wellbeing support. However, entry and access to the school is always at the discretion of the Principal. Please note that whilst we will make every endeavour to accommodate the request for the delivery of services at school, we cannot guarantee it. We are required to consider a number of factors including the student's educational and wellbeing needs, the school's ability to provide appropriate facilities for therapy and the ability of the student to access the service outside of school hours.

In 2024, in accordance with CEWA guidelines and procedures, parents/guardians must request for the delivery of external services at school by using the "Request to School for Clinical Access" form. This form is on the school's website and a copy can also be obtained from the office. Please note that all requests MUST be made by the parent/guardian and not by the external service provider.

Following the parent request, the Principal will make a decision regarding it. If the request is granted, a Third-Party Clinical Access Agreement will be completed by the service provider, parent and school. Before being granted access to work with any child, the service provider will be required to complete certain legal requirements. We thank you for your understanding. UNIFORM PRICE INCREASES IN 2024

We have been advised that school uniform prices will increase in the new year. This is due to increases in the cost of living, transportation and manufacturing. A suggestion is that you may wish to purchase uniforms by the end of this year to avoid the increases.

SCHOOL UNIFORMS - URGENTLY WANTED

Children who are leaving the school or have grown out of their school uniforms are asked to contact the Uniform Shop and arrange for them to be donated. Second-hand uniforms, which are sold on or donated to other families within the school, are done so at significantly reduced prices. (All funds raised from second-hand sales are re-introduced into resources for the students.) You are also welcome to donate these uniforms to the front office.

WHITE SPORTS SHOES

Please be reminded that if you are buying new sports shoes for 2024, they need to be **predominantly white with white laces**. Multicoloured or black sports shoes are not part of the school uniform. Thank you for your co-operation in this matter. (More information is available in the uniform section of the school website.)



NEW SKORT SCHOOL UNIFORM

Families should note that a new skort will be added to the school uniform that can be worn all year round. In summer, this can be worn with the blue short sleeved shirt, sandals or socks and school shoes. In winter, it can be worn with the blue long-sleeved shirt, school jumper, tights or socks and school shoes. We hope that this addition to the school uniform provides more flexibility for the students playing at recess and lunch.

Parents should note that both the Summer dresses and Winter pinafores will remain as part of the school uniform into the foreseeable future for those families who still would like to use these garments.



UNIFORM SHOP

In 2024, the Uniform Shop will only be open on a <u>FRIDAY MORNING 8:15am - 8:45am to TRY ON SIZES</u>. All school uniforms will be able to be purchased at any time <u>ONLINE</u>. Separate instructions, with the procedure for ordering, is available on the school website.

PARENT VOLUNTEERS AT ST ANDREW'S CODE OF CONDUCT & WWCC REQUIREMENTS

PAYMENT OF SCHOOL FEE ACOUNTS

The School Fee Account will be forwarded at the start of the school year with the Payment Option Form attached. Every family is required to complete and return the Payment Option Form in February indicating their chosen payment plan option to meet the costs associated with your child's education.

Please note payment arrangements are not carried over from year to year and each family will still need to complete the Payment Option Form annually.

School Fee accounts are emailed to each families' nominated email address at the commencement of the school year. Reminder accounts will be sent out each term.

Fees are to be paid REGULARLY throughout the year and are due in FULL by the end of NOVEMBER unless other arrangements have been put in place after a discussion with the school.

The Signatories to the student enrolment contract are liable jointly and severally to pay, and agree to pay, to the school, for all fees and charges incurred in respect of that student, regardless of:

- (a) Any pre-arranged or subsequent private agreement to share or apportion payment responsibility.
- (b) Any Court Order or statutory direction that may apply to any signatory.
- (c) Any separate or individual invoicing of any amount.

This joint and several liability includes all costs that may be incurred by the school in the recovery of fees and charges including legal action, if necessary.

NON-PAYMENT OF SCHOOL FEES

Families are required to inform the school Principal of any financial hardship that may result in delay of school fee payments. The school makes every effort to work with parents in relation to the payment of school fees. Where parents have ignored all reasonable attempts to negotiate a fee reduction strategy or have failed to pay school fees and further action is required, the school will follow the guidelines of Catholic Education WA. If a suitable resolution to the non-payment of fees is not reached, the services of a Debt Collection Agency will be sought. Notice will be given in writing to the family of such intention prior to action being taken. Costs associated in debt recovery will be passed on to the family and collected via the agency appointed. The next step would be for a summons to be issued. However, before enforcement proceedings are taken, approval from the Executive Director of Catholic Education of WA will be obtained.

FAMILY FEF ASSISTANCE

Any family who is unable to meet the full commitment of fees must make an appointment at the beginning of the year with the Principal to discuss alternative arrangements. At this appointment, the family must bring financial documentation from a recognised Australian Authority i.e., The Australian Taxation Office or Australian Government to prove financial hardship. The appointment will not go ahead without this documentation. All information relating to family financial situations will be treated as highly confidential.

WITHDRAWAL OF STUDENTS

The Principal must be given a **full term's notice** in writing prior the student's withdrawal. Without such notice, the school reserves the right to charge a term's fee in lieu of notice.

Direct Debit

This allows your school fee account to be paid automatically to the school from a nominated bank account by weekly, fortnightly, monthly, quarterly and semester instalments. Direct Debit Authorisation and Payment Plan Options are attached to the Annual Statement and also available from the office on request.

HEALTH CARE AND PENSION CARD SCHOOL FEE DISCOUNT SCHEME (HCC AND PCC)

This scheme assists all families that hold current Family Health Care and Family Pensioner Concession Cards. The discount is on tuition fees for Kindergarten to Year 6 students as per Catholic Education of Western Australia's recommended school fee policy.
