Tomorrow is the feast day of St Ignatius of Loyola. Ignatius was born at Loyola (Spain) in 1491. He died in Rome on 31st July in 1556. He was a Spanish nobleman trained in diplomacy and the use of arms. Ignatius was wounded in battle against the French. The experience of conversion, while convalescing led him to write the Spiritual Exercises. Loyola then founded the now famous Society of Jesus (Jesuits) and became the first superior general. He is remembered for his loyalty to the Church and its renewal, his ministry to the marginal, his concern for education, and his dedication 'to the greater glory of God', the motto of the Jesuits.


