### **IRENE McCORMACK – BRIDGE BUILDING COMPETITION**

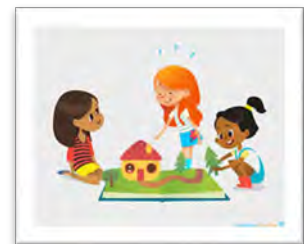

## CHANGE – SEASONS FOR GROWTH PROGRAMME



Seasons for Growth is a programme that supports children with issues around death, divorce, separation and serious losses or changes in their lives. At such times grief is experienced, many different emotions arise and need to be addressed and healed. Learning about feelings and knowing how to handle emotions can help children adapt to the changes in their lives more readily. Whilst a parent may have moved on with their life after divorce or separation, a child may not be ready, needing some extra help.



The programme is conducted during school hours, working groups of no more than eight, focusing on peer support, with a Companion, Sister Wendy. Each child is given a journal which is supplied by the school.

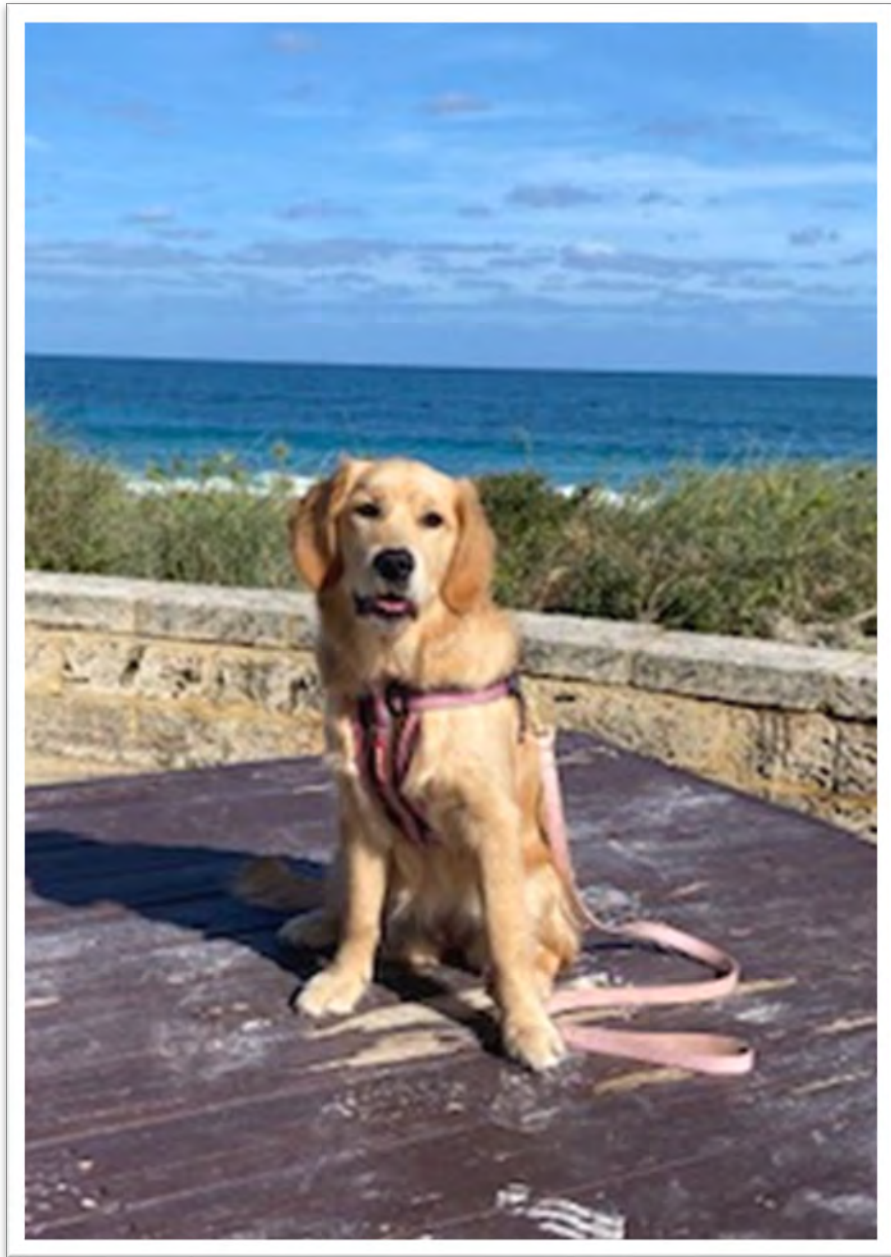
