### Dear Parents,



The evening will again be separated into three discos ensuring each group has a great time and we comply with safety considerations:

Years 1 to Year 3 5:15 – 6:30pm

Years 4 to Year 6 7:00 – 8:30pm

- A reminder to parents that children must be escorted to and from the undercover area on the night – PLEASE REMEMBER TO abide by the rules for the event.
- Drop off at the door near the year 6 classrooms & pick-up from the Southern door on the hall's side of the undercover area.
- Parents are invited to stay and watch the Kindy/PP disco however, the other two discos will be drop off only.
- Please note that only younger siblings are permitted at the Kindy & PP disco and no other siblings (younger or older) will be allowed at the other discos.
- No student or siblings from other years will be able to attend a disco that is not allocated for them.
- Siblings will also not be allowed to play anywhere else on the school grounds.
- Any children who are on school grounds unsupervised during sibling discos will be asked to leave.

- Discos are for current St Andrew's Primary School students only.
- Parents please note: If you are staying for the Kindy/ PP Disco, we remind you, as per our school
  policy, to refrain from videoing or photographing children other than your own children at the disco.
- No phones or devices are permitted into the disco. If you insist that your child requires a phone
  on the night, it can be signed in when you drop them off and will be looked after by the volunteers
  during the disco.
- The discos are free dress but please ensure that students are dressed appropriately for the night.
   A light snack of a packet of popcorn will be provided on the night.
- Children are welcome to bring a labelled water bottle and they will also have access to the water fountains.
- As only a light snack is provided, please make sure your child eats before or after the event.
- A Big Thank You in advance to all the parents who have volunteered to assist on the night
   without you, the event would not be possible. Again, please remember social distancing
   whilst supervising the kids.
- It would be appreciated if all volunteers could report to the sign-in tables (Outside Y6 classrooms)
  on arrival.

# **Years 2 - 6 St Andrew's Cross-Country**



### **Dear Parents**

Next Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> June, is our School Cross Country Carnival. Below is an approximate guide as to when each year level will commence their event. Parents are welcome to attend, however we require all spectators to socially distance on the hill. Please note that the times below may vary on the day.

Year 2 is running 750m (one lap around the course).

Year 2 girls will be starting at 9.00am and Year 2 boys will be starting at 9.10am.

Year 3 will be running 1500m (Three laps around the course).

Year 3 girls will be starting at 9.20am and Year 3 boys will be starting at 9.35am.

Year 4 is running 2000m (four laps around the course).

Year 4 girls will be starting at 9.50am and Year 4 boys will be starting at 10.05am.

Recess 10.20am-10.40am

Year 5 are running 2500m (Five laps around the course).

**Year 5 girls** will be starting at 10.50am and **Year 5 boys** will be starting at 11.05am.

Year 6 is running 2500m (Five laps around the course).

**Year 6 girls** will be starting at 11.20am and **Year 6 boys** will be starting at 11.35am.

Cross Country will finish at approximately 12pm.

- Presentation of medals and the Cross-Country faction shield will be at approximately 1.15pm out on the oval.
- The 5 fastest boys and 5 fastest girls from each year level selected will be notified in writing of their qualification for the inter-school Cross-Country. Selection is based on times recorded in sports lessons, running club times and the Cross-Country Carnival times. Selected students will be encouraged to attend future running club sessions. Other students not selected are welcome to continue participating at running club on Tuesday and Thursday mornings from 7.40am 8.10am, in preparation for the Athletics Carnival in Term 3.
- Please note we are planning on having a coffee van at our school Cross-Country Carnival.
