



PHONE CALLS TO THE OFFICE

Calls made to classroom teachers are NOT put through to the classrooms during school time. Teachers are working with your children and they are not available to take your calls. A message can be left for the teacher or you may email them via the school email address: admin@standrews.wa.edu.au. The office staff are also handling too many messages from parents to students; especially late in the school day. Messages for students, which are received early in the day are placed in classroom message bags. These are picked up from the office each day at about 2.00pm. There are no guarantees that messages that are phoned through after this time will be delivered due to the administrative pressures that office staff experience late in each school day. You should make all arrangements for pick up with your child before they come to school.

CONFIRMATION



Next term will see the process for the **Sacrament of Confirmation** take place for the Year 6 children who will be candidates. This sacrament takes place in Term 3. The process for Confirmation will closely resemble that of Reconciliation and Eucharist. The key requirements are:

- Attendance at any Parish Mass over the weekend of 30th/31st July for Confirmation enrolment. (Enrolment cards will be provided to your child next Term by the Year 6 teachers. They can be filled out at home and handed in at one of the Masses).
- Attendance at the Candidate and Parent workshop: <u>Tuesday</u>, 2nd <u>August</u> at SACPS Hall at 6.00pm.
- Candidate attendance at the Confirmation Retreat on <u>Thursday 4th August</u>. (Held during school hours and attended by all Year 6 students).
- Confirmation rehearsals will be held on <u>Friday</u>, <u>12th August</u>. (Held during school hours).
- The Celebration of the Confirmation Mass is on Tuesday, 16th August at 6.00pm.

The following information is required for Confirmation:

- 1. The selection of one or two sponsors in Confirmation. These are ideally the Godparents who have maintained a deep relationship with the child. Sponsors should be practising Catholics, over the age of 16. They cannot be Mum and Dad but can be older siblings, Grandparents, or close friends who have a connection to the candidate. They can live or be away interstate or overseas on the day of Confirmation and Mum or Dad can be proxies in their place.
- 2. The location and details of your child's Baptism church, parish, suburb, city, country. (Exact date)
- 3. Mother's full maiden name and Father's full name.
- 4. It is advisable that the candidate commence reading about the lives of Saints. The candidate should select a Saint in Confirmation based on discernment of the Saint's values, qualities or behaviours that the candidate admires and recognises as desirable in their own life.

FREE DRESS DAY - PYJAMA THEME

Next Thursday, on 30th June the children can come dressed in their pyjamas and dressing gowns etc to school for a gold coin donation. All money raised will be sent to the Archbishop's Life Link Appeal and the St Vincent Winter Appeal. Please ensure that appropriate footwear is still worn.



SEMESTER ONE REPORTS

School Reports will be available via SEQTA on the afternoon of 24th June, after school. A Pupil Free Day is set aside for Parent – Teacher Interviews. This will be held on Friday, 1st July. Of course, if you have had an interview recently with your child's classroom teacher, then you are not expected to attend another interview on this day.



PARENTING IDEAS - SCHOOL REPORTS

Reports can mean anxious times for children. Will my parents be disappointed or proud? This is a main concern for most children. Student reports bring mixed feelings for parents. Pleasure and pride if they are performing well but considerable angst when children are not progressing as you hoped. Children of all ages take their cues from their parents, so your reaction to their school reports can affect the way they see themselves as learners and as people. Before you look at the report, do a little self-check to see if you are in the right frame of mind.

- 1) Are your expectations for your son or daughter realistic and in line with their ability? Expectations that are too high can turn children off learning. Too low and there is nothing for them to strive for.
- 2) Do you believe that children learn at different rates? There are slow bloomers, late developers and steady-as-you-go children in every classroom, so avoid comparing your child to siblings, your friends' children and even yourself when you were a child. **Instead, look for individual progress**.
- 3) Are you willing to safeguard your child's self- esteem rather than deflate it? Self-confidence is a pre-requisite for learning, so be prepared to be as positive and encouraging as possible.

Some ideas to consider when you look at your child's report:

- Focus on strengths.
- Take account of your child's effort and attitude to learning.
- Broaden your focus away from just academic learning How does your child perform socially?
- Take note of any student self-assessment.
- Discuss the report with your son or daughter.

SCHOOL PHOTOS



Dear Parents.

The school photo orders came home with your child this week. Please note the following:

- Magnetic photo frames and additional prints are slotted between the prints of your package.
- Key chains are packed separately and distributed by the school office to the classroom teachers, who then distribute to the students. Check with your teacher if you have not received yours yet.
- Sibling photos (if applicable to your school) are delivered to the eldest child and placed inside their photo package as additional prints if applicable.
- Digital negative orders will be sent to your email address supplied within 3-5 days of the school photo delivery. Don't forget to check your junk mail folders.
- You are still able to place additional orders via the Kapture website including orders for sports, music or special group photos taken on school photo day. Use the same school code as previously supplied.

If you ordered photos more than 10 days after photo day, your order will be handled separately and mailed directly to your home address within the next 28 days. Check your confirmation email for more information.
