SCHOOL REPORTS - MID YEAR

Many hours have recently gone into writing reports and completing the task brings satisfaction. I thank all of the teachers for being so conscientious in preparing the mid - year reports. **They will be available on SEQTA after school on Friday, 23rd June.** The grades for each learning area are put on the reports after work samples and assessments have been thoroughly examined. There should be no surprises on the report – you should be aware of what your child does in class and the results that they have been achieving. We should remember:

- Report forms are one specific way of reporting and that there are many other forms of reporting that happen in the classroom, every day.
- Each child develops at their own individual rate.
- Don't compare your child's report with another in the classroom or family member.
- Children always need positive encouragement and a discussion based on what has been achieved.

To give you an opportunity to discuss aspects of the report and your child's progress with the classroom teacher, **Parent Interviews will be held all day on Friday, 30**th **June.** This time has been set aside for you to come in for an interview. (*If you have seen your child's classroom teacher recently, you are not expected to arrange another interview.)* I also ask that if you have a specific concern about an area of your child's progress that you let the teacher know **before** the interview.



Teachers will be placing a Report Interview sheet on their door on Thursday, 22nd June, and you are asked to fill in the time that you would like to see them. If this day is not suitable and you still would like to see the classroom teacher, then please contact them directly and arrange another suitable time.

Mid Year School Reports will be issued in a digital format through the app, 'SEQTA Engage'. You should have received an invitation to this app. We ask that you please respond as soon as possible to this invitation. Please note that paper reports will <u>not</u> be issued. Once downloaded, this app will allow you to access all past academic reports easily. Should you require any assistance, please do not hesitate to contact the school.

DRIVING AND PARKING AROUND THE SCOOL GROUNDS

The teachers have been instructed to dismiss their classes immediately at 2:45pm. Children have been spoken to about getting straight to their point of departure. This action, in conjunction with thoughtful and courteous movement along the Kiss N Ride, should create a more fluid exit from the school precinct. Remember, if on arrival at school you can't enter the Kiss N Ride, it is best to drive north along Victorsen Parade and park in Waring Park car park until traffic is less congested or park there, collect your children and then walk them back to your car. *Do not double park or leave your car in the Kiss N Ride when picking children up or dropping off.* There are many car bays in and near the school. These are located along Victorsen Parade, opposite the Kiss N Ride, outside the school Hall, at the Church, along Waring Green and there are large numbers of car bays at Waring Park.

SCHOOL PHOTO DAY IS COMING!

Dear Parents,

Your school photo day is coming! Approximately two weeks prior to the photo day every student will receive a personalised flyer to bring home from Kapture Photography containing your child's unique codes for ordering school photos online.

KEEP YOUR FLYER SECURE!

The unique codes contained on the flyer will be issued only once.

Order EARLY for sibling photography

Sibling photos can ONLY be ordered online. Once you receive the personalised flyers for your children, it is imperative that you order your sibling photo early to avoid missing out! There is a physical limit in the school schedule to how many sibling photos can be taken. Once the maximum capacity of sibling orders has been reached, no more sibling orders can be placed.

If maximum capacity is not reached, sibling orders **close 12pm midday sharp**, **one business day prior** to the first photo day.

The school or the photographers <u>cannot</u> accept late orders for sibling photography. Please do not ask as your request simply cannot be accommodated.

Order EARLY for discount photo day prices

Order your photos within 10 calendar days of photo day to receive discount photo day prices. Late orders are handled separately to the school delivery and incur a \$30 custom service charge.

Other information

Your school will notify you in a few weeks when **team and special group photos** are available to view and purchase on the Kapture website. Please note; class, individual and sibling portraits are not available to view online prior to purchase.

Kapture offer a money back guarantee for any parent who is not fully satisfied with their photo package. Should you have any queries before or after photo day, please check the FAQ's on the Kapture website.

All students will be photographed individually on photo day for school administration records AS WELL as included in their class group presentation available for purchase to all families. Should there be any reason why your child should <u>NOT</u> be included in the photo shoot –please contact the school office.
