
CONFIRMATION REHEARSALS - THURSDAY 10th AUGUST

We will be celebrating a School Mass at approximately 8:50am on Tuesday, 15th August. We cordially invite all members of the St Andrew's School community to join us in celebration.




BEST WISHES TO MS WELLS

The theme for 2023 is "Read, Grow, Inspire".


Please ensure that if your child is wearing a costume that they have suitable footwear and clothing for the rest of the day at school. (There will be no run club on that Tuesday morning).
