Dear Parents and Guardians.

A reminder to all families that:

To our Kindergarten Parents, please note that only Pre-Primary students receive formal digital reports. We have invited you to SEQTA Engage to make accessing reports easier next year. SCHOOL CROSS COUNTRY CARNIVAL

Our annual School Cross Country Carnival for Years 2 to 6 is scheduled for tomorrow. Weather permitting, we intend to proceed with our Cross Country Carnival tomorrow. Given the weather forecast, students will remain in class and each year level will come out for their race only. If there is rain, we will attempt to run the races between showers.

We will endeavour to follow the <u>proposed timetable</u> set out below. Please note that this timetable may change because of weather conditions.

- Year 2 to Year 5 events before recess (first race at 8:45am)
- Year 6 events will be held after recess (commencing at 10:40am)
- In every year group, the girls will run first, followed by the boys.

We intend to proceed with the presentation of Cross-Country medals at approximately 12 noon in the Hall. Please note that the timing of this is again dependent on the weather.

Parents are welcome to attend. There will be a coffee van for your convenience.

SCIENCE INCURSION

Last week, our Years 1 and 3 students enjoyed a science incursion from Australian Earth Science Education. The Year 3 students learned about how fossils are formed and what they can tell us about the past. They then made their own fossils. The students in Year 1 were shown the composition of visible light by using diffraction glasses. They then made some pipe-cleaner jewellery which reflected the ultraviolet rays of the sun! This was a fabulous learning experience and I thank Mrs Young for organising this event.

SPORT NEWS

FACTION CROSS COUNTRY CARNIVAL FRIDAY 31ST MAY

Our School Cross Country Carnival is scheduled for Friday, 31st May. Parents are welcome to attend the events. We will commence our day at 8:45am. Please note that we will endeavour to run our Year 2 to Year 5 events <u>before</u> recess (recess will commence at 10:25am). Our Year 6 events will be held <u>after</u> recess (recess will conclude at 10:40am). Please note that these times are an <u>approximate guide only</u> and may change on the day. In every year group, the girls will run first, followed by the boys. The event details are:

- Year 2 1000m
- Year 3 1500m
- Year 4 2000m
- Year 5 2500m
- Year 6 2500m

Please note the following additional information:

- Presentation of medals and the Cross-Country faction shield will immediately occur after the Year 6 events (<u>before the lunch break</u>). The presentations will occur in the Hall and all parents are welcome to attend.
- The 5 fastest boys and girls from each year level selected will be notified in writing of their qualification for the Inter-school Cross-Country. Selection is based on times recorded in sport lessons, running club times and the Cross-Country Carnival. Selected students will be encouraged to attend future running club sessions. Other students, not selected, are welcome to continue participating at running club on Tuesday and Thursday mornings from 7:40am 8:05am, in preparation for the Athletics Carnival in Term 3.
- Please note that we are planning on having a coffee van at our Cross-Country Carnival.
- Children can wear their faction-coloured T shirt for the day.
- Please, no coloured hair or coloured zinc for this event.
- Whilst we want every child to have an opportunity to compete, once they start walking substantially, they will be exited from the race (as we have limited time for each race).
- Please consider bringing a water bottle, towel and a change of shoes / clothes.
- The CANTEEN WILL BE OPEN for food requirements.
- Parents are invited and should stay on the bank of the oval and not visit the children in the faction tents.
- IF LIGHT SHOWERS ARE FORECAST, THEN WE PLAN TO RUN RACES BETWEEN THE SHOWERS. Therefore, our schedule of events and times will be altered to reflect this. The carnival will be held with modified rules. Simply, each grade will come out to the oval, at a selected time, and complete their cross-country laps. They will then return to class.

SCHOOL PHOTO DAY IS COMING!

Dear Parents,

Your school photo day is coming! Approximately two weeks prior to the photo day every student will receive a personalised flyer to bring home from Kapture Photography containing your child's unique codes for ordering school photos online.

KEEP YOUR FLYER SECURE!

The unique codes contained on the flyer will be issued only once.

Order EARLY for sibling photography

Sibling photos can ONLY be ordered online. Once you receive the personalised flyers for your children, it is imperative that you order your sibling photo early to avoid missing out! There is a physical limit in the school schedule to how many sibling photos can be taken. Once the maximum capacity of sibling orders has been reached, no more sibling orders can be placed.

If maximum capacity is not reached, sibling orders **close 12pm midday sharp**, **one business day prior** to the first photo day.

The school or the photographers <u>cannot</u> accept late orders for sibling photography. Please do not ask as your request simply cannot be accommodated.

Order **EARLY** for discount photo day prices

Order your photos within 10 calendar days of photo day to receive discount photo day prices. Late orders are handled separately to the school delivery and incur a \$30 custom service charge.

Other information

Kapture offer a money back guarantee for any parent who is not fully satisfied with their photo package. Should you have any queries before or after photo day, please check the FAQ's on the Kapture website.

Students who are unable to attend school photo day can book a studio appointment at our Malaga office to be photographed during school holidays.

Your school will notify you in a few weeks when **team and special group photos** are available to view and purchase on the Kapture website. Please note; class, individual and sibling portraits are not available to view online prior to purchase.

All students will be photographed individually on photo day for school administration records AS WELL as included in their class group presentation available for purchase to all families. Should there be any reason why your child should <u>NOT</u> be included in the photo shoot –please contact the school office.


PARISH NEWS
