WORK COMPLETED IN THE SCHOOL HOLIDAYS

A number of significant works projects have been completed over the school vacation. The major projects included the deployment of big screen televisions in all remaining classes including the Mary MacKillop Centre, replacement of several air conditioners, upgrading all toilet blocks and washrooms within the school, replacement and upgrade of electrical switch boards within the school, emergency shut off valves installed for all water outlets within the school, air conditioner filters cleaned and / or replaced, replacement of hall perimeter fencing and the regular maintenance that is always completed pursuant to our maintenance schedule.

2025 CLASSES - REQUESTS

A few parents have written to me with regards to classes in 2025. We are blessed at St Andrew's to have teachers of the highest calibre. I feel that your children will be well catered for. Most classes work collaboratively together during portions of the day.



Parents <u>SHOULD</u> assume that the current teachers will remain in their current grades for next year and that the <u>CURRENT CLASS STRUCTURES WILL REMAIN THE SAME</u> <u>FOR NEXT YEAR.</u> No final decision as to which teacher is teaching which grade has been made, but a number of staff will change grade next year.

Parents need to take into consideration that there are only 2 classes per grade and that <u>children will be split</u> from their previous year. Your current teacher has your child's best interest at heart and will attempt to place them into the best class for their needs. Parents should also be aware that if a teacher is requested, then <u>your child may not be placed in the same class as their friends.</u> Also, it may be necessary that friendship groups be split for optimum learning to occur. The classroom should be viewed as a place for learning to occur. (A conversation with your child's current teacher may be a good starting point.) Parents should not request a teacher and then friendship groups. It is one or the other and if a request is put in for both, then it will be completely discounted.

I will acknowledge your request and they will be taken into consideration. Unfortunately, I cannot give any guarantee for requests made.

All requests must be made in writing and are exactly that, a request and no guarantee can be given. Once classes have been set and announced there will NOT be any alterations to class groupings. Please send all requests to the school email address:


